Board Report



The HOA Board of Directors is continuing to work on projects to improve our community space. We have received approval to install one water fountain in the smaller storm pond, but the window to have it installed for this season has passed. We are going to have the power lines installed in October so we will be ready to install the fountain in the spring and enjoy it next summer. We are also planning on installing more winter-season decorative lights this year at the main entrance of our community as well as at the lookout. Watch for that in December.

The waterfall in the larger storm pond has been running well all summer. It is scheduled to be shut down for the winter in the first week of October, with plans to install it again next summer.

The Board is concerned about two issues that still appear to be detracting from the beauty of our community space and the utility of the Lake Club facilities. We continue to see some members entering the Fitness Centre with dirty outdoor shoes and using the equipment. Some of these occurrences have even been by underage residents without the required adult supervision. We have also noticed a lot of cigarette butts left at the benches in the park area.
