

GRANDPARENT SCAM PRESENTATION

In May a presentation was given at the Lake Club by a Calgary Police Service officer to raise awareness about the latest scams. The presentation was an eye-opener for many as it highlighted the intricacies of the scams and how they can be avoided.

The devastating effects of scams can never be overstated. It is not only a financial loss but can also lead to emotional distress and even physical harm in some cases. Therefore, staying informed about current scams and how to avoid them is of utmost importance.

Scammers are becoming increasingly sophisticated in their approach, making it more challenging for individuals to identify and avoid fraudulent activity.

During the presentation, the police officer discussed the latest scam techniques and how they can be identified. She also shared some real-life examples of people who have fallen victim to these scams. One of the most common scams discussed was the "Grandparent scam". The presentation also included insights on how to protect oneself from such scams, including tips on how to verify the identity of callers and emails.

Unfortunately, many people fall victim to grandparent scams each year, losing thousands of dollars to these criminals. It's important to be aware of these scams and to educate elderly family members on how to avoid them.

What is a Grandparent scam?

A grandparent scam is a type of scam that targets elderly people. The scammer will contact the victim, pretending to be a grandchild or another family member in need of urgent financial assistance. They will often claim to be in trouble, such as being arrested or in a car accident, and will ask the victim to send them money immediately. These scams rely on the victim's emotions and desire to help their family members. The scammer will often use personal information they have gathered about the victim and their family to make the scam seem more convincing. They may also use pressure tactics, such as threatening the victim with legal action or harm to their loved ones, to get them to send money quickly.

Overall, the presentation was informative and enlightening. It served as a reminder that **scams can happen to anyone**, and it is essential to stay vigilant. The police officer urged everyone to report any suspicious activity to the authorities and to stay informed about the latest scams. By doing so, we can protect ourselves and our loved ones from falling victim.

Some tips for avoiding grandparent scams include:

- Never send money to someone you don't know well, especially if they are asking for it urgently.
- Always confirm the identity of the person you are talking to before sending money.
- Ask them questions that only your real family member would know the answer to.
- Be cautious of unsolicited calls or emails asking for money or personal information.
- Report any suspicious activity to the authorities immediately.



A mean lord exiles fairy tale creatures to the swamp of a grumpy ogre, who must go on a quest and rescue a princess for the lord in order to get his land back.




June 10 — Anna and the King (1999) PG-13 with Jodie Foster and Cho Yun-Fat

The story of the romance between the King of Siam and widowed British schoolteacher, Anna Leonowens, during the 1860s.




June 11 — My Fair Lady (1964) G with Audrey Hepburn and Rex Harrison
