BOARD REPORT

The HOA Board of Directors thanks everyone who participated in Ice Cream Social on June 14. It was a very good turn out and we enjoyed catching up with many of you and meeting new neighbours.

We look forward to seeing you and your family at the summer event on July 19. Look for the details in this newsletter and invite your neighbours to come as well.

Here is an update on the improvements we have been working on:

- The new floor to ceiling mirror has been installed in the gym. This mirror really looks great.
- The repairs, cleaning and restaining of the East fence are complete. The fence looks brand new.
- The three new benches for the park have been ordered. They are scheduled to be installed in the next few days.
- The water pump for the waterfall was installed on June 6. After some technical issues with the timer, which was eventually replaced, the waterfall is now functioning well. It is programmed to come on at 7:00 am and turn off at 9:00 pm each day.
- The acquisition and installation of two water fountains for the ponds is awaiting approval from the City. We don't yet know how long the approval process will take.

Community Pickleball



We're happy to share that the HOA has recently purchased a new pickleball net, paddles, and balls for the enjoyment of all Lakes at Rocky Ridge residents.

All HOA members are welcome to use the equipment for private games, but we kindly ask that a few simple guidelines be followed:

- **Reservations are required. You can book the equipment online by scanning the above QR code or simply email the Lake Club Manager at activity.lakeclub@outlook.com to reserve your preferred time slot.**
- The equipment is for use only on the community tennis court at 10427 Rocky Vista Dr. NW and may not be taken offsite.
- Bookings are limited to 3 hours per session.
- Equipment is stored in the Lake Club Gym, next to the entrance shelving unit. **Please return all items to the gym promptly after your game; same-day returns are required.**
- The tennis courts are owned and operated by the City of Calgary and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. They cannot be reserved.
- If the court is occupied when you arrive, the current players have up to 30 minutes to finish their game.
- The HOA is not responsible for managing disputes with other court users or the City of Calgary.

If you notice any damage or wear, please let us know so we can keep the equipment in good condition for everyone. The equipment is intended for use by HOA members, their families, and guests. Please play safely, use is at your own risk; the HOA assumes no liability for injuries or accidents.

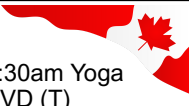
