August 2 — The Penguin Lessons (2024) with Steve Coogan, Jonathan Pryce, Bruno Blas

Rated PG for strong language, some sexual references and thematic elements (1h 51m)

A disillusioned Englishman who goes to work in a school in a divided Argentina in 1976 finds his life transformed when he rescues an orphaned penguin from the beach.



August 9 — The Ballad of Wallis Island (2025) with Tom Basden, Tim Key, Sian Clifford

Rated PG for some language and smoking (1h 39m)

An eccentric lottery winner who lives alone on a remote island tries to make his fantasies come true by getting his favorite musicians to perform at his home.



August 16 — The Best Exotic Marigold Hotel (2011) with Judi Dench, Bill Nighy, Maggie Smith

Rated PG for sexual content and language (2h 4m)

British retirees travel to India to take up residence in what they believe is a newly restored hotel. Less luxurious than advertised, the Marigold Hotel nevertheless slowly begins to charm in unexpected ways.



August 23 — How to Train Your Dragon (2025) with Mason Thames, Nico Parker, Gerard Butler

Rated PG for sequences of intense action, and peril (2h 5m)

As an ancient threat endangers both Vikings and dragons alike on the isle of Berk, the friendship between Hiccup, an inventive Viking, and Toothless, a Night Fury dragon, becomes the key to both species forging a new future together.



August 30 — A Beautiful Mind (2001) with Russell Crowe, Ed Harris, Jennifer Connelly

Rated PG for intense thematic material, sexual content and a scene of violence (2h 15m)

A mathematical genius, John Nash made an astonishing discovery early in his career and stood on the brink of international acclaim. But the handsome and arrogant Nash soon found himself on a harrowing journey of self-discovery.
