To me, movie nights are a wonderful way for neighbours to connect, enjoy great films, and experience movies together in our beautiful theatre.



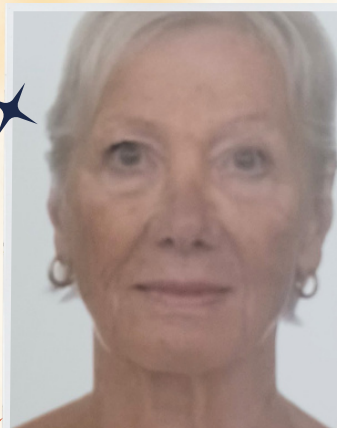
Rod

COMMUNITY PICKLEBALL




We are pleased to share that pickleball equipment is now available for all members of The Lakes at Rocky Ridge community to borrow and enjoy. All members are welcome to use it for private games, but we ask that a few simple guidelines be followed:

- Reservations are required. To book equipment, please email the Lake Club Manager at activity.lakeclub@outlook.com to secure your preferred time slot.
- The equipment must be used only at the community tennis court located at 10427 Rocky Vista Dr. NW and may not be taken offsite.
- Bookings are limited to 3 hours per session.
- Equipment is stored in the Lake Club Gym, next to the entrance shelving unit. Please ensure all items are returned to the gym immediately after use, as same-day returns are required.
- Please note that the tennis courts are owned and operated by the City of Calgary and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Courts cannot be reserved in advance. If the court is in use upon arrival, current players are permitted up to 30 minutes to finish their game.
- The HOA is not responsible for managing disputes with other court users or the City of Calgary.
- If you notice any damage or wear to the equipment, please let us know so it can be addressed promptly and kept in good condition for everyone.
