

happening around the city this month.

BMO Centre/Festival of Crafts Check schedule for December craft fairs

Santa visits & photos at many markets and malls—check individual market pages (Millarville, Spruce Markets, and community centres).

Family performances of The Nutcracker (children's matinées) Multiple matinees on weekends during the ballet

Heritage Park Once Upon a Christmas — Weekend daytime story & activities for children (multiple dates December 6–23).

Theatre Calgary, Vertigo Theatre, and other local companies December programming includes seasonal shows, comedies and dramas, check each company for exact dates/ticketing

Calgary Philharmonic Seasonal Concerts — Orchestral holiday programs and Special seasonal experiences & dining Holiday dinners — Fundraising gala events (Heritage Park & others), ticketed festive dinners and charitable events occur in early—mid December (watch community calendars for bookings).

Twinkling lights at the Lookout








A resident recently popped into the office with a fantastic idea to highlight our beloved pets throughout the community.


