

The Pavilions Ladies Craft group would like to express a sincere thank you to all our neighbours for helping us to raise over \$200 at the October 5th garage sale in the Lake Club, by donating to our cause. When yarn goes on sale, and with other discounts, that will buy us more than 70 balls of yarn. As each ball of yarn knits up 1.5 toques or more, that lets us knit a further 105 or more toques from this community to donate to keep heads warm!

The week after the garage sale 180 toques were taken to the Drop In Centre, 200 went to The Mustard Seed, and 143 children's toques went to Inn from the Cold – for a total of 523 toques. Add that to the 300 that went to the Drop-In Centre in early May, and that means we have donated over 820 hand knit toques so far this year. And the year isn't over yet....!

Again, thanks so much to those who support us with yarn and \$\$\$ to purchase when necessary.
