We wish to thank all residents for adhering to this policy.



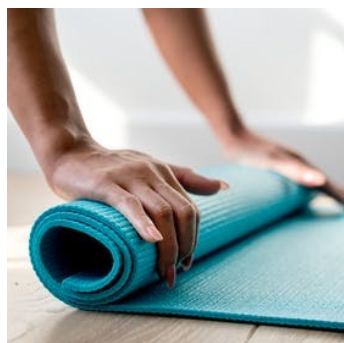


International Club

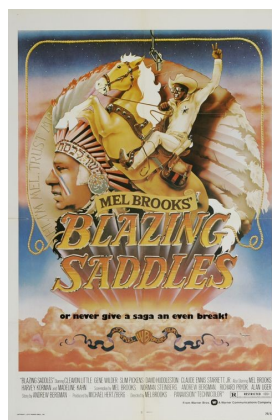


November 16, 2019 Spider-Man: Far From Home

friends Ned, MJ, and the rest of the gang on a European vacation. However, Peter's plan to leave super heroics behind for a few weeks are quickly scrapped when he begrudgingly agrees to help Nick Fury uncover the mystery of several elemental creature attacks, creating havoc across the continent!

Little and co-star Gene Wilder have great chemistry, and the delightful supporting cast includes Harvey Korman, Slim Pickens, and Madeline Kahn as a chanteuse modelled on Marlene Dietrich. Some of this film's sequences, notably a gaseous bean dinner around a campfire, have become comedy classics.
